The facebook



'Facebook' was created by Mark Zuckerberg, aged 23, while he was studying psychology at Harvard University. He was an intelligent computer programmer as he had already created some social-networking websites for his classmates.

In February 2004, Mr Zuckerberg began '*The facebook*'. The network became popular to other Boston universities very quickly. It became '*Facebook.com*' in August 2005 after the address was bought for \$200,000. US high schools could sign up from September 2005, however, UK universities could sign up the following month.

Users can create profiles with photos, lists of personal interests, contact information, and other personal information. Users can communicate with friends and other users through private or public messages or chat. Facebook users are 'power users' as they have the power to connect, post and tag themselves and others.

To have a 'Facebook' account you need an e-mail address and a user name. The side is free to join and users through their privacy settings, can control who sees their information, as well as who can find them in searches.

In September 2012, the company said that the number of registered users is over one billion, making it the largest social-networking site.
