Food for a community

Milpa Alta is a region of twelve villages and towns, to the south of Mexico City. In Milpa Alta, traditions are still very important and one of the most famous traditional events is a community meal. It takes place every Christmas and is called *La Rejunta*. It's a feast, where about sixty thousand tamales and fifteen thousand litres of hot chocolate are made and consumed by as many as 20,000 people. Tamales are made from corn and that is related to the name of Milpa Alta that means 'High cornfield'.

The planning and organisation of *La Rejunta* takes the whole year. Every year, different people are given the job of *majordomo*, which means they're responsible for organising the meal. There's a waiting list for the opportunity to do this and currently the next available year is 2046. This year's *majordomos* are Virginia Meza Torres and her husband Fermín Lara Jiménez, who put their names on the list 14 years ago.

One year before the meal, men go to the forest and collect wood that they store near the home of the *majordomo*. It must be dry when it's used to make the cooking fires. Local farmers grow most of the corn, meat and vegetables that are needed as ingredients. In the week before the feast, hundreds of volunteers arrive to help with the preparation and the cooking. No instant or ready-made foods are allowed. Amazingly, everyone seems to know what they must do. On the day of the feast, the *majordomos* and others have to stay up all night to cook.

For the people of Milpa Alta, eating together is one of their most important traditions. One woman, Josefina García Jiménez, explains that sitting together at the table is like a glue that keeps people together. She says "It feels like I am passing down a tradition, and when they are adults, they will remember what I have done. Here we have time to cook, time to think about the ingredients, time to show our kids that we love them through cooking. The time that everybody stays at the table after the meal has finished is just as important as the food. They talk, tell stories, and laugh together." At Christmas, *La Rejunta* is a giant version of a family meal.
