- Make 3-4 paragraphs.
- Use the correct style: A friendly email with short forms and informal language.
- Greeting: Begin with: ***Hi/ Hello/ Hi there...***
- Refer to all notes given.
  - Note 1: Thank their friend for the invitation – say that they are very excited too.
  - Note 2: Ask who the artist is and if they are famous.
  - Note 3: Ask about the venue and the time.
  - Note 4: Ask if their friend can accommodate them and what to bring along.
  - Note 5: Ask what else they would do while they are there.
- Signing off: ***See you soon/ Write back soon/ Lots of love/ Best wishes...***

A. Write a story for an English teenage magazine beginning with the following sentence:

*“I was scared stiff! Entering that horrible house was the worst idea I’ve ever had.....”*

Students are expected to:

- Give a **title** to the story.
- **Begin** the story with **the given sentence**.
- Make 3-4 paragraphs:
  - Set the scene for the story: Describe who was there and when it happened.
  - Describe the action – say what happened.
  - Say what happened in the end and how the people felt – finish in a satisfying or surprising way.
- Use past tenses (ex. Past Simple, Past Continuous, Past Perfect Simple).
- Use rich vocabulary, linkers, connecting words, adjectives.
- Use a variety of long and short sentences to create suspense.
- Include direct speech to make the story more vivid.

**B. Write a review on the following topic.**

***A lifestyle magazine has asked for reviews of places to eat in your area.***

***Is there a posh restaurant you have visited recently?***

***What was it like?***

***If you send us your reviews by the end of the month, two lucky winners will receive two free meals at the restaurant of their choice!***

**Students are expected to:**

- use formal/ semi formal writing & linking words to connect their ideas.
- give an interesting title.
- make 3- 4 paragraphs:

§1: Introduction: name, location/ accessibility, type of restaurant (cuisine ethnic or traditional), when and with whom they went.

§2: Description of décor, food and service

§3: Point out 2-3 things they liked and if there is a downside it should be mentioned here

§4: Conclude by stating their opinion clearly and saying if they would recommend the restaurant, to whom and why.

- Use appropriate vocabulary for reviews, linkers, connecting words, adjectives
- No repetition
- Present and past tenses should be used
