It was absolutely true! Adriana and Tamara were twin sisters!

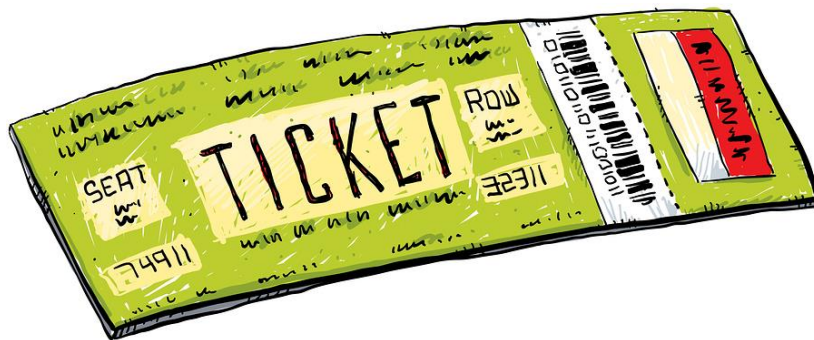

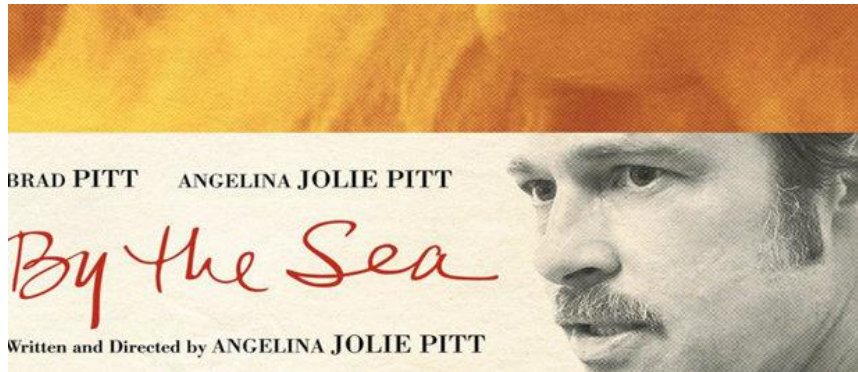
