PART I : WRITING

(35 MARKS)

Marking based on: 'WRITING ASSESSMENT RATING SHEET (35 MARKS)'

Topic 1. WAY 1: S states his/her opinion on the issue right from the start and expands to support it with justification/exemplification/ mentioning contradictory points of view (e.g. 'Of course there are those who argue... etc.)

WAY 2: S writes a balanced piece of work, possibly covering 3 areas:

- a. those who prefer to go out/meet people/socialise and why they do this...
- b. those who prefer to stay in... , plus their reasons.
- c. S's opinion usually (but not necessarily) in the last paragraph.

TOPIC 2... SIMILAR PROCEDURE AS IN Topic 1.

WAY 1: S states his/her opinion on the issue right from the start and expands to support it with justification/exemplification/ mentioning contradictory points of view (e.g. 'Of course there are those who argue... etc.)

- a. those who are in favour and why...
- b. those who are against, plus their reasons.
- c. S's opinion usually (but not necessarily) in the last paragraph.
