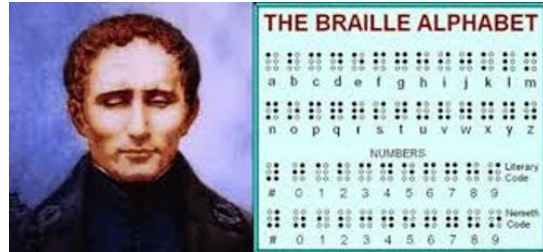
PART II: READING COMPREHENSION

The history of Braille

Louis Braille was born in 1809 in a small town near Paris. Louis often played with the tools his father used in his workplace. When he was three years old, he had a terrible accident. **(1)** The doctor couldn't help him, and by the time he was four, Louis had become blind.



Louis started school when he was six. He was a clever boy but it was hard for him to study. **(2)** He could only listen to his teachers. There was a special school for blind children in Paris, and when Louis was 10 years old, his parents decided to send him there.

The new school was nice and the teachers were friendly and not very strict. There were special books with letters that pupils could feel with their fingers, but they were very hard to read. **(3)**

After Louis had been at the school for two years, a soldier visited the school. He had invented a code so that soldiers could give each other secret information at night. The code had 12 dots that the soldiers “read” with their fingers. When Louis heard about the code, he thought he could find a way to use it for blind people. **(4)** Then he arranged the six dots for each letter in different patterns. That’s how he invented the Braille alphabet.

When Louis was 20, he published his first Braille book. By the time he was 28, he had invented Braille symbols for maths and music too.

Today, 200 years later, blind children and adults all over the world use Braille in different languages. They can read books and magazines. **(5)** Blind people use Braille phones and computers, and they even play games like Monopoly in Braille. Braille has really changed life for blind people.

Brad Pitt was born as William Bradley Pitt on December 18, 1963. He is the eldest of three children and grew up in Springfield, Missouri. His father, Bill Pitt, owned a trucking company, and his mother, Jane Pitt, was a family counsellor. Pitt originally aspired to be an advertising art director, studying journalism at the University of Missouri.

Pitt told his parents he intended to enroll in the Art Center College of Design in Pasadena, but instead spent the next several months driving a limousine. He joined an acting class and, shortly after, accompanied a classmate as her scene partner on an audition with an agent.

Brad acted in many movies and won awards for his performance as an actor and as a producer too in 2013 and in 2014.

Brad has got six children – three biological and three adopted- from his marriage to Angelina. His biological children are a girl named Shiloh and the twins; a boy, Knox Leon, and a girl, Vivienne Marcheline.

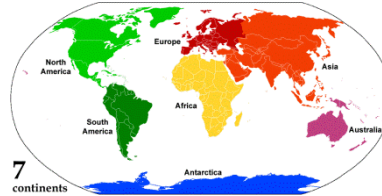
