The Cyprus Research Centre (CRC) since its foundation in 1964 aims in the conduct of cyprological research both from Cypriot as well as foreign academics, the preparation of research programmes and the promotion of scientific work in all aspects of humanities concerning Cyprus. To achieve these aims, the CRC promotes, inter alia, the organization and the creation of scientific archives in which archival material is gathered. In this context, the creation of the Archive of the History of Greek Cypriot Education (AHGCE) has commenced in September 2021.

The AHGCE is the first Archive to be devoted exclusively to the History of the Greek Cypriot Education, covering the period from 1800 to the present. The creation of the AHGCE is based on the identification, collection, recording, classification, digitization, documentation and final disposal, in digital form, to the research and educational community, of both archival and bibliographical material in relation to the history of Greek Cypriot Education in Cyprus from the early 19th century to the present day. The creation of the AHGCE primarily serves in rescuing and promoting the archival material, which is to be found in the “historical” schools of Primary, Secondary and Technical Education in Cyprus. Further to the archival material from public schools, the AHGCE gathers material from ecclesiastical archives, the archives of School Boards, and other public or private collections such as libraries, museums and cultural foundations.

The archival material includes letters, memos, catalogues, minutes books, disciplinary board books, management team meeting books, activity reports, school property books, study certificate books, student rolls and registers, grades, reports, circulars, photographic material, reports on educational reforms, research by experts, documents of current affairs on education as well as bibliographical material, such as monographs, articles, edited volumes, conference proceedings, doctoral theses, studies and journals concerning education.
