Extreme Jobs

Nature of Extreme Jobs

- Attract people willing to (1) push their limits and face danger
- Involve a high level of risk
- Require mental and physical strength
- Need to have a (2) strong sense of responsibility and commitment

Example 1: Deep-Sea Diving

- **Background:** became popular in 1970; oil companies moved into deeper waters.
- **Location:** the (3) North Sea and other parts of the world
- **Life on the job:** high physical and mental pressure; easy to lose life → during some operations, divers stay underwater for up to (4) twenty-eight / 28 days.

Example 2: Firefighting

- **Nature of work:** dangerous situations on a daily basis
- **Purpose:** to protect people and (5) property
- **Safety measures:** strict procedures followed at all (6) times to reduce risks.

Working Conditions

- **Time away from home:** long periods, sometimes for months
- **Environment:** extreme conditions, hazardous locations, very (7) low temperatures
- **Experience:** places humans have never set foot on; things few people have seen

Training and Requirements

- **Training:** essential part of preparation
- **Knowledge & physical ability:** understanding of physics and physical fitness → better chance of surviving an (8) accident
- **Key quality:** staying (9) calm under pressure

Overall Message

- **Who can do these jobs:** not everyone
- **Important qualities:** (10) dedication, discipline and courage
