Nicole Fayolle has been living on a narrowboat for almost five years. She bought it in Belgium and has been travelling along canals and rivers in Europe since then. She chose this **lifestyle** because she loves to travel and wanted to visit different places without leaving her home. For Nicole, this way of life is very special because she can move from place to place and still feel at home every day.



Nicole is a painter, so living on the boat helps her a lot. She can keep all her equipment with her and work every day. She often sits on the deck and paints, then goes inside to relax with a cup of coffee. She also loves to cook her own meals. This daily **routine** makes her feel comfortable and happy, and it also helps her stay **creative** and focused on her work.

Most nights, Nicole stays in special areas for boats where there is water and electricity. However, she sometimes prefers to stop in a quiet place in the countryside. She enjoys the beautiful views and the peaceful atmosphere. She can spend hours painting and enjoying

nature, especially when she sees birds near the water. These moments are very important for her because they give her new ideas.

The boat, called Liberté, is about 20 metres long, but the inside space is quite small. There is a kitchen, a small bedroom, and a tiny bathroom. The boat also has heating, which is very important during the cold winter months. Nicole has made the living room comfortable because she sometimes spends a lot of time inside. The large windows let in plenty of light, which is perfect for painting.

Nicole also has a dog called Candy who keeps her **company**. She enjoys having her dog with her and they often enjoy long walks in the countryside. Nicole is also part of a friendly narrowboat **community**. She keeps in touch with other people by phone or email. In winter, they often stay in the same place for several months. This helps her build strong relationships and gives her life some stability.

Nicole does not stay on the boat all the time. She has a bicycle and often goes to nearby villages to buy food and other things she needs. She buys homemade bread and fresh herbs for her cooking.

Overall, Nicole is very happy with her lifestyle. She enjoys her freedom and the chance to live and work in different places. Her only regret is that she did not start this life earlier.
