In the evening, they play board games. They never watch TV. Before they sleep, Grandma makes hot chocolate for everyone. They go to bed at a quarter to ten.

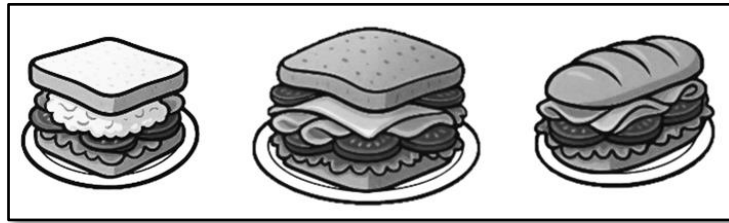
