Students are expected to:

- make paragraphs
 - Opening: ***Hi, / Hello, / Hi there, etc.*** (other informal greetings accepted)
 - Tell Michael how they are.
 - Say if they have a best friend and introduce them.
 - Describe what the friend's personality and appearance are like.
 - Describe what they do with the friend.
 - Closing: A short sentence to close the email and sign off ***See you soon, / Write back soon, / Lots of love, / Best wishes, etc.***
- use mainly the Simple Present.
- use informal language.
- use a variety of adjectives.

8) Choose ONE of these questions. Write your answer in about 100 words. (1x20=20 marks)

A. You have decided to enter a short story competition. The competition rules say that the story must end with the following sentence:

“It was a day I will never forget”.

Your story should be about 100 words.

Students are expected to:

- write a narrative (story format).
- make at least 3 paragraphs or more:

Introduction:

-Students set the scene (when / where / who / initial feelings etc.)

Main Body:

-Students describe the events in the order they occurred.

-Students describe what happened in the end.

-Students describe their feelings.

Conclusion:

-Students describe their feelings/thoughts and must end with the sentence given.

- use mainly Past Tenses.
- include a clear beginning, middle and ending to the story.
- make the story logical and connected.

B. You have a blog that is about the best places in the world. Write a blog entry with the following title:

The city where I would choose to live

Your blog entry should be about 100 words.

Students are expected to:

- use informal / semi-informal language.
- use mainly Conditionals, Present Tenses, Comparatives / Superlatives, Descriptive Adjectives etc.
- include their opinion.
- make 3- 4 paragraphs:

Introduction:

-Students introduce the city (name, location etc.)

Main Body:

-Students describe the city (climate, lifestyle, people, culture, attractions, work opportunities etc.)

-Students say what they think life would be like in this city.

Conclusion:

-Students sum up and say why they would choose to live in this city.
