- Taking a pet is a permanent commitment (and not a rush decision).
 - ✓ Some countries have stopped animal adoptions during the holidays to discourage careless adoptions that often lead to animals being returned or abandoned.
- Adopting a pet requires a lot of consideration.
 - ✓ Costs can exceed expectations (if a pet gets sick and requires surgery).
 - ✓ Pets require a lot of attention / care / children can lose interest fast.
 - ✓ How much space the animal needs and the right environment are important considerations.
