Traffic Policing → Road Policing

Background

Project EDWARD was created in **2016** by TISPOL

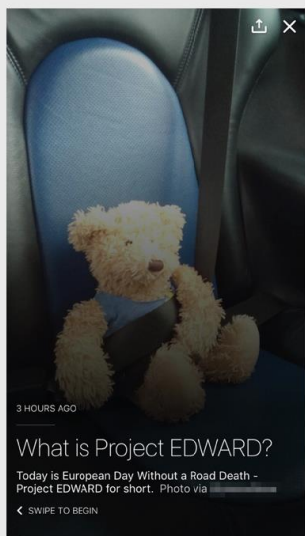
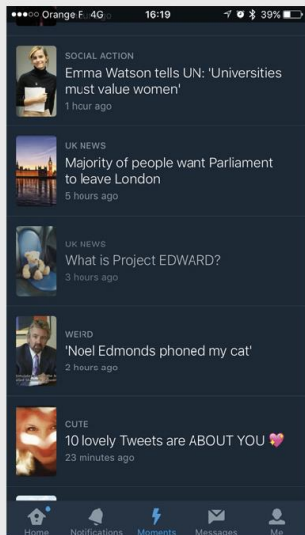
The initiative ran on **Wednesday 21 September**

Its purpose was clear:

- ▶ to raise awareness of road safety issues across Europe
- ▶ to unite the efforts of police, public sector, private enterprise, groups and individuals to deliver a day where no one would die on the roads of Europe
- ▶ to spread the word far and wide through social media – by encouraging everyone to reflect on how they could be safer on the roads

European Day Without A Road Death

Results from 2018

- ▶ 24 European countries took part, with events and promotional activity
- ▶ There were no road deaths in 18 of these 24 countries
- ▶ Cyprus 2016, 2017, 2018: 0 death
- ▶ However, results show a total of 50 fatalities in total.
- ▶ Twitter reach of nearly 38 million, starting on 11 June and ending on Friday 21 September.
- ▶ On Project EDWARD day alone, the reach was 25 million
- ▶ We had extensive support from organisations and individuals – including F1 racing hero Nico Rosberg, who tweeted on EDWARD day.

Project EDWARD 2019

- ▶ Thursday 26 September
- ▶ Conference to be held in Dublin
- ▶ Live web broadcast from Dublin Castle
- ▶ Close collaboration with ETSC
- ▶ Live link with Road Safety Support event in Manchester
- ▶ Support once again from Michelin and other loyal organisations
- ▶ A series of national road trips is planned
