Advantages and Disadvantages of TV

Introduction

Some people claim that television is the root of all evil, while others think of television as a best friend. Some blame the television for society's violence, consumerism, and misinformation, while others see it as a rich resource for education and global understanding.

Main Part

➤ **Advantages of Watching Television**

1. In this busy, expensive life, television is an easy and cheap source of entertainment.
2. By watching international news, we are kept informed and up-to-date with breaking news around the world.
3. Educational programs that can increase our knowledge and make us more aware of the world around us.
4. Easy access to all kinds of information
5. Television can help you feel less lonely. Television can fill the shoes of absent friends or family.
6. TV can expand your mind. - Different people, cultures, ideas, and places you might never encounter in real life.
7. Gathering around the television gives families, friends, and strangers something to bond over.

➤ **Disadvantages of Watching Television**

1. Sex, crime, and violence on television may have negative effects on children (and adults!). Aggressive or violent behaviour - Viewers sometimes imitate violent, criminal, sexual, or other risky behaviour they see on television.
2. Too much television is not good for your health. – Obesity - sleep difficulties, - eye problems - behaviour problems - lower grades
3. Television makes us antisocial, taking the place of family and friends.
4. TV takes the place of important, enriching things like interacting socially with other human beings, being physically active, reading, doing homework or chores, or spending time with hobbies like art, music, etc.

5. It can also portray idealized lives and body types that negatively impact viewers' self-esteem.
6. Consumerism: Television's ulterior motive is to get us to buy, buy, and buy.
7. Television might be addictive.
