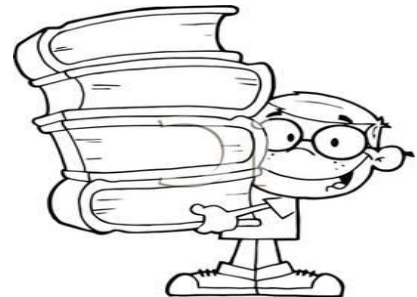

An Italian court of appeal has said food theft because of hunger is not illegal. The Supreme Court of Cassation reversed the conviction of a 1. \_\_\_\_\_ man, Roman Ostriakov, who was given 2. \_\_\_\_\_ months in jail for stealing cheese and a sausage worth \$4.50. He was also fined \$115. His lawyers appealed for a 3. \_\_\_\_\_

in that fine and got the whole conviction quashed. The court said taking the food “does not constitute a crime” because he stole a small amount of food out of 4. \_\_\_\_\_. It ruled that stealing small amounts of food because of hunger is not a 5. \_\_\_\_\_.
