POINTS THE CANDIDATE IS EXPECTED TO DEVELOP

Advantages: arguments in favour of studying Abroad

The arguments imply the importance of studying in a different country from one's home country:

- 1. It can help students improve their language skills.
- **2.** Students learn how to budget.
- 3. It helps develop independence and in effect confidence.
- **4.** Students can experience different teaching styles.
- **5.** It may impress potential employers.
- **6.** Students mingle with people from different countries and cultures and become more openminded.
- 7. Students can expand their network.
- **8.** It opens a window of opportunities for work abroad.
- Disadvantages: arguments against studying abroad

The arguments imply the negative effects of studying in a foreign country:
