PART I: WRITING (30 MARKS)

This part of the exam consists of TWO writing tasks. You must do BOTH tasks.

1. Write a story of 100-120 words for an English magazine beginning with the following sentence: "I was at a café with my friends last night when someone stole my mobile phone".

(15 MARKS)

The students are expected to narrate a story in the first person. The story should have an interesting plot with a climax and a clear ending. They should make at least three paragraphs and use past tenses (Past Simple, Past Continuous and Past Perfect) and time words and phrases to describe the order of events. They should also use Direct speech, passive voice, adjectives, adverbs and words or phrases that show feelings.

2. The Internet is one of the greatest inventions of the 20th century. What do you think? Write an article whether you agree or disagree expressing your opinion on the above statement supporting it with examples. Write about 100-120 words. (15 MARKS)

The students are expected to write four short paragraphs: an introduction, two main body paragraphs and a conclusion which will include their opinion. The students may either agree, disagree or present both sides of the argument.

Arguments to support the statement: [any three of the following]

The internet is used

- a) at home, work and school (online lessons, work from home, do projects, do homework)
- b) to find all kinds of information on any topic
- c) to communicate with everyone around the world it is an easy and cheap way (e-mail, phone, text)
- d) for entertainment
- e) online selling and buying things

Arguments against the statement:

- a) danger of addiction (online gaming/ surfing)
- b) information may be wrong
- c) danger of fraud
