- Friendly. A good neighbor will always try to be friendly, available, and approachable. ...
- Quiet. One of the important qualities to look for in a good neighbor is whether they are quiet. ...
- Respectful. Good neighbors respect each other. ...
- Mature. Good communication among neighbours always helps dealing with any disagreements or future problems...
- Helpful. In case you are in need you may have someone to help.
- Trustworthy. He/she can be trusted for important issues that may occur.
