Appearance (clothes, make up, hair styled, body shape, hair implants, improve body parts etc.)

Advantages

- receive an unbelievably large amount of positive attention due to human tendency to judge others by outer appearance
- receive flattering comments about your appearance
- success in school: teachers/classmates can be more positive towards you/ help more easily, even do favours for you
- social life: be more popular, invited to parties, fun events/ success with the opposite sex
- enhances career prospects /more carrier opportunities: usually beautiful people do better at job interviews especially in the entertainment industry.
- Feeling of belonging, acceptance, inclusion
- Boost your self-confidence and self esteem
- Love yourself /you look the way you like
- Believe in yourself and your potentials: be more productive, efficient at work/school

Disadvantages

- Fake friends/ can be with you to show off
- Pressure on you, you are expected to look good all the time, so that when you don't look particularly good one day, people usually point it out
- Not be taken seriously for a relationship
- Neglect your mental, spiritual world/inner beauty
- Cause health problems: diets, eating disorders, anorexia
- Risk of damaging your appearance during an unsuccessful operation
- Getting stressed even depressed to look better and better
- Requires time and money (plastic surgeries are costly)
- Attract stalkers in your real life and on social media
- Cause rivalry and jealousy /some people are suspicious of you, and are not very friendly
