- Stand on your own two feet / more confident
- Chance to be creative, decorate in your own style/reflect your personality.
- Enhances social and personal life, throw parties, invite friends late at night, play any kind of music an any time

Disadvantages

- Too many expenses rent, bills, groceries/ hard to save money/ less social life
- More responsibilities, cleaning and maintaining your place, doing the washing up, laundry etc. time consuming.
- In case of an emergency: no unconditional family support around
- Feel lonely, scared, nervous
- Sense of freedom can bring the worst habits out, encourage irresponsible behaviour
