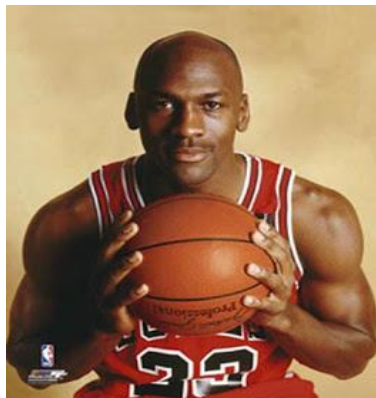

AIR JORDAN



Michael Jeffrey Jordan, also known as 'MJ', is without a doubt the greatest basketball player to have ever lived. Michael was born on February 17th 1963 in New York, USA. He was the fourth of five children.

In 1968, his family moved to Wilmington, North Carolina where Michael went to school. At school Michael was a good athlete at basketball, baseball and football, but very soon his love for basketball was clear. In his last year at school, he received a scholarship from the University of North Carolina where he went on to study Geography. During his college life, he won many basketball matches and awards.

After graduating, Michael went on to play professional basketball for the Chicago Bulls and the Washington Wizards. Jordan led the Bulls to a record of 72 wins in the 1995-96 NBA season. Jordan earned the nickname "Air Jordan" because of his jumps and his slam dunks. Michael also won two Olympic gold medals with the USA basketball team.

On October 26th 1984, Jordan signed his first multimillion contract with Nike and so the famous Air Force 1 trainers were born. Thirty-nine years later and these trainers are still a global fashion. Michael also starred in films, music video clips and commercials.



Today, Michael lives in Florida with his wife Yvette and their twins Ysabel and Victoria. Michael also has three children from his first marriage: Jasmine, Jeffrey and Marcus.

TEXT MESSAGING



One of the most popular ways of communication has turned 30 years old. The very first text message was sent on December 3rd, 1992. It was sent by Neil Papworth, a software engineer, to his boss at the British mobile phone operator Vodafone. It simply read "Merry Christmas". They had no idea then that this simple form of communication would become so popular around the world. SMS stands for Short Message Service.

Today, it is a multi-million-dollar industry all around the world. Everyone, from presidents to school children to villagers in faraway places, uses text messaging. People send an estimated nine trillion text messages each year. SMS is now a part of our everyday life. It is a favourite method of communication between families and friends. One study showed that the average American teenager sends up to sixty texts a day.

However, SMS is blamed for the increase in car accidents since drivers text while driving. It is also believed to be the reason for the decrease in language ability. This is because a new kind of language has spread worldwide. Texters find shorter ways to write their messages by sending the fewest possible characters. Texting shorthand such as LOL (laughing out loud) and OMG (oh my God) has even entered the Oxford English Dictionary.

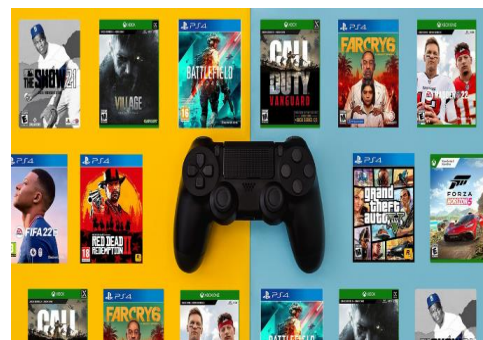
