Tour de France

The Tour de France is an annual bicycle race primarily held in France. It consists of 21 stages, lasts 23 days and covers around 3,500km. It was the first bicycle race ever organised, and it is considered the most **prestigious** one worldwide. The race has been held annually since it started in 1903, except during the years of the two World Wars when it was cancelled.



The first Tour de France was organised in 1903. It was a five-stage race held from May to July, starting in Paris and stopping in Lyon, Marseille, Bordeaux, and Nantes before returning to Paris. Cycling is an endurance sport and the competitors had to cycle during the day and through the night to complete these stages. Only 15 competitors took part in the first race as it seemed too difficult and too long. The following year the organisers **reduced** the distance, cut the duration to 19 days, dropped night riding, and increased the prize money. These changes attracted almost 80 competitors, among them not just professionals but **amateurs** as well.

As the years passed, more and more cyclists, some from other countries, entered the race, and soon the Tour de France became the world's biggest **annual** bicycle race. Although it **initially** ran only in France, it soon started to include stages in nearby countries; Belgium, Germany, Italy, and Spain have all hosted parts of the race in the recent years. The route changes each year, but the finish line is always set in Paris.

Traditionally, the race is held in the month of July; the only exception to this in recent decades was the 2020 race, whose start was postponed to 29 August due to the COVID-19 pandemic. This was the first time that the Tour de France was not held in the month of July.

The winner of the race is awarded the privilege to wear the “yellow jersey”, a symbol of the tour de France. Prize money is awarded as well. From 20,000 francs the first year, prize money has increased each year, although from 1976 to 1987 the first prize was an apartment. The first prize in 1988 was a car, a studio-apartment, and 500,000 francs in cash. Prizes in cash only returned in 1990. Nowadays the winner takes home €500,000. The cyclist who gets the second place gets €200,000 and the third place €100,000.

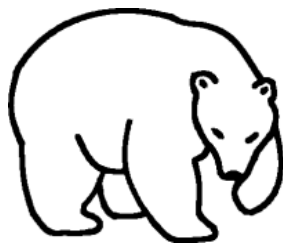
Tourist survived polar bear attack in Norway

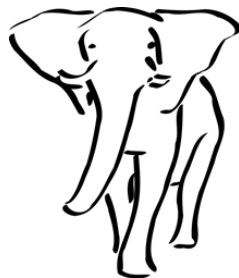
