CHESS

Chess is called the game of kings. It has been around for a long time. People have been playing it for over 500 years. Chess is based on an older game from India. The chess we play today is from Europe.

Chess is a two-player game. One player uses the white pieces. The other player uses the black pieces. Each piece moves in a special way. One piece is called the king. Each player has one king. The players take turns moving their pieces. If a player lands on a piece that belongs to the other player, he or she takes it. The game ends when a player loses his or her king. There are a few more rules, but these are the basics.



Some people think that chess is more than a game. They think that it makes the mind stronger. Good chess players use their brains. They take their time. They think about what will happen next. These skills are useful in life and in chess. Chess is kind of a workout for the mind.

You don't always have lots of time to think when playing chess. There is a type of chess with short time limits. It's called *blitz* chess. In *blitz* chess, each player gets ten minutes to use for the whole game. Your

clock runs during your turn. Once you hit the time clock after your move, your clock stops while starting the other player's clock. If you run out of time, you lose. Games of *blitz* chess are fast paced.

Chess is not just for people. Computers have been playing chess since the 1970s. At first, they did not play well and made mistakes. As time went on, computers became stronger chess players. In 1997, a computer beat the best player in the world for the first time. It was a computer called Deep Blue. Deep Blue was a really big computer which took up a whole room. By 2006 a cell phone could beat the best players in the world. Chess has surely come a long way. Don't you think so?

Football, also known as soccer in certain parts of the world, was invented more than a century ago in Britain. However, the Chinese claim that it was invented by them. Even before the invention of modern football, many versions of this game were played in different parts of the world.

Football has been recognized as one of the most popular games across the globe. It is played by more than 250 million people and watched by billions of enthusiastic football fans. Several football tournaments are held each year at national and international level. The popularity of this game can very well be judged by the excitement that builds among the fans during these matches.

Just like every other game, football also has a certain set of rules that define the way it should be played and determine which team is the winner. A football match lasts for 90 minutes, and it is played in two halves with a 15' break between them. Players wear a special kit (a T-shirt and shorts), football boots and shin pads during the match. The goalkeepers wear padded gloves to protect their hands and to help them catch the ball more easily.

The Fédération internationale de football association (FIFA) organizes the Football World Cup every four years. Football teams from various countries participate in the world cup. This is one of the biggest sports events worldwide and is awaited eagerly by football fans who travel from all over the world to watch their favourite team playing live on the football field.


