Suggested answers:

Advantages:

1. Access to a wide variety of opinions and perspectives.
2. Ability to quickly and easily get answers to questions.
3. Anonymity may make it easier to ask sensitive or embarrassing questions.
4. Opportunity to connect with people who may have similar experiences or interests.
5. Can be a cost-effective alternative to hiring a professional.

Disadvantages:

1. Quality of advice may be unreliable or incorrect.
2. Lack of personal interaction and rapport with the advisor.
3. Difficulty in verifying the qualifications and expertise of the advisor.
4. Communication barriers such as language or cultural differences.
5. The advice given may not be tailored to individual circumstances and therefore may not be effective.
6. Risk of receiving biased or inaccurate advice due to personal opinions.
