Provide more details about the topic. Use lots of adjectives and verbs and relay your thoughts and emotions.


Conclusion:

A suggested plan is:

Title

Paragraph 1: Introduction

- State the background
- Basic facts of the matter.

Paragraph 2: Summary information

Give quantified information about the programme (how many attendees were there, how long the sessions were, space etc)

Paragraph 3 and 4: Analysis

Develop review statement in paragraph 3 and treat the alternative point in paragraph 4 from your own point of view.

Paragraph 5: Conclusion

Restate your review sentence and then write a closing sentence to end the review.
