# Plickers



## What is Plickers?



Plickers is an interactive tool that allows teachers to conduct live assessments without student devices.



## How does it work?



Each student holds a unique Plickers card, which he/she rotates to indicate an answer.



The teacher scans the cards with a mobile device, and responses are recorded in real-time.

# Why use Plickers in the EFL Classroom?

**Engagement:** Keeps students actively participating, especially in larger classes or with younger students.



**Immediate Feedback:** Students and teachers see the results instantly, making it easy to determine comprehension.



**Non-Threatening Assessment:** Since students don't need to speak out, it's great for building confidence.



**Versatility:** Can be used in various activities, from quizzes to opinion polls, without relying on extensive resources.

# Using Plickers in an EFL Classroom

## Vocabulary Review:

- Display vocabulary-related questions where students select the correct definition or synonym.

## Grammar Checks:

- Create questions that focus on grammar structures, like identifying correct verb forms or sentence structure.

## Reading Comprehension:

- Pose questions based on a reading passage to check for comprehension.

## Pronunciation Practice:

- Use Plickers for matching phonetic transcriptions with words or identifying word stress patterns.

# What You Need to Use Plickers in an EFL Classroom

- 1. Teacher's Device (Smartphone/Tablet)**
  - For scanning responses and viewing results.
  - Plickers app required (Free download on iOS/Android).
- 2. Classroom desktop** to access Plickers website.
- 3. Projector or Smartboard**
  - Useful for displaying questions and showing live results to the class.
- 4. Plickers Cards**
  - Printable, unique cards for each student.
- 5. Classroom Setup**
  - Arrange space for students to hold cards without crowding.
  - Ensure good lighting for accurate scanning.



# Setting up Plickers



## Sign Up and Set Up Classes:

- Create a Plickers account on [www.plickers.com](http://www.plickers.com) and add your class rosters for easy tracking.



## Print and Assign Cards:

- Download free Plickers cards and assign each student a unique card.
- Each card has 4 orientations (A, B, C, D), which represent multiple-choice options.



## Prepare Questions:

- Design questions on the Plickers app or website; they can be saved for easy reuse.

# Sample Quiz Ideas



## Example 1: Vocabulary Quiz

"Which of these words is a synonym for 'happy'?"

- A. Joyful
- B. Sad
- C. Angry
- D. Tired



## Example 2: Grammar Check

"Which sentence is correct?"

- A. She don't like apples.
- B. She doesn't likes apples.
- C. She doesn't like apples.
- D. She don't likes apples.



## Example 3: Reading Comprehension

After reading a short passage, ask:

- "Why did the character go to the market?"



**Answer options based on passage details.**



# Implementing Plickers in Assessment

**Formative Assessment:**  
Use Plickers as a quick check for understanding after lessons.

Identify students who may need additional help on specific topics.

**Summative Assessment:**  
Conduct end-of-unit quizzes to evaluate overall comprehension and mastery.

Track student performance over time to understand progress and growth.

**Self-Assessment & Reflection:**

Allow students to self-assess their confidence level in a topic; use Plickers as a quick survey tool to gauge overall class comfort.

# Tips for successful use of Plickers

## Card Management:

- Laminate cards to prevent wear and tear.
- Ensure each student understands how to orient the card correctly.

## Classroom Setup:

- Make sure you can scan cards easily without students crowding each other.
- Test the scanning angle and lighting beforehand.

## Student Feedback:

- Review results in real-time with students to reinforce learning.

# Let's sum up!

- **Key Points Recap:**
  - Plickers enhances engagement, is easy to set up, and provides quick feedback.
  - Useful in EFL vocabulary, grammar and comprehension checks.
  - Encourages active learning and supports formative assessment. Ideal for vocabulary, grammar, and summative assessments, too.
