Bilingual Literacy Project, Poetry Workshop

On 11 March 2026, during the first break in the school library, students participated in a small yet highly creative poetry workshop organised as part of the school's activities for World Poetry Day. The workshop introduced students to the value and expressive power of poetry, while also familiarising them with key poetic concepts such as verse, stanza, metre, and literary devices including simile, metaphor, hyperbole, personification, and onomatopoeia. Following the presentation, students took part in a creative writing activity during which they had the opportunity to compose their own poems, encouraging imagination, self-expression, and appreciation for literary art.

In addition, the interdisciplinary “Bilingual Literacy Project”, which ran from December 2025 to May 2026, aimed to strengthen students' literacy skills through reading, creative writing, illustration, and digital content creation. Working collaboratively, students read stories, wrote and illustrated their own texts, produced videos, and presented their work, developing not only their language skills but also their creativity, teamwork, and digital competencies.
