The “Biannual Peer-to-Peer Social Awareness Seminars” are events where students present important social issues based on research and then participate in meaningful discussions. The seminars are held under the auspices of the Ministry of Education and encourage young people to express their opinions and exchange ideas. At the 10th Pancyprian District Seminars, which took place on April 24, 2026, at the OELMEK building, our school proudly participated with the guidance of our teachers.

Our teams presented two different topics. The first presentation, “Erasmus+ One Week Abroad, A Lifetime of Impact,” highlighted how educational experiences abroad help young people gain knowledge, confidence, and a broader understanding of different cultures. The second presentation, “Think Before You Share: Sexting & Youth Protection,” focused on the dangers of sharing personal content online and the importance of prevention and awareness.
