Address by the Minister of Education and Culture

The Ministry of Education and Culture is continuing, for the sixth consecutive year, its cooperation with cultural and educational institutions and organisations through a series of actions, organised in and beyond the classroom, which contribute to the enhancement of music education and culture in general.

The educational programmes presented in this publication take place within the scope of a music education programme, which aims to develop a lifelong connection between Cyprus' young people and music. This is realised through a variety of music experiences, music appreciation, composition and performance, as well as the active and creative participation of young people in contemporary social and cultural affairs and opening channels of communication between the school and the community.

The recent Education Reform has also centred on music education, and key to the reforms in this area has been the establishment of the Music Schools. Indeed, Music Lyceums have already established a successful presence in the local cultural scene. As of the school year 2015-2016, the institution of Music Schools has expanded, and Music Schools are now functioning in all districts of unoccupied Cyprus. An important aspect of the Music Schools' programme are the educational actions and programmes that are presented through the synergies of Music Lyceums with institutions such as the Cyprus Symphony Orchestra Foundation, municipalities, local communities and renowned Cypriot and foreign artists, working together for the production of cultural events such as the opera "Cavalleria Rusticana" and a tribute to Beethoven's known and unknown works.

With an aim to further upgrade the quality of music education offered by public education in Cyprus, the Ministry of Education and Culture has continued its support of the Music Schools institution by establishing

Music Schools in lower secondary education. As of September 2015, three Music Gymmasia have begun functioning at the districts of Ammochostos, Larnaka and Lemesos.

The development of young peoples' musical talents is also supported through the Regional Orchestras of Nicosia and Pafos and the range of activities they organise. Their activities include music workshops, charity concerts, and participation of their members in the annual university and secondary school students' event "Musical Vibes".

Moreover, the Ministry focuses on ensuring students' equal participation and access to opportunities in education and culture by offering music education programmes to all Cyprus schools and reaching as many students as possible. Partnerships with institutions such as the Pharos Arts Foundation, the Photos Photiades Foundation, the Cyprus Symphony Orchestra Foundation, OPAP Cyprus and others, allow, through the sharing of financial costs, the organisation of a greater number of actions at a time when the financial crisis seriously threatens cultural development. A large number of students have thus been offered the opportunity to participate in educational programmes of the Cyprus Symphony Orchestra and the Pharos Arts Foundation as well as educational concerts, open rehearsals and musicians' visits to schools and actions, such as the annual "Marios Tokas song composition contest" for students and "Choir Day".

It is with great pleasure that I commend the continuation of such valuable partnerships and welcome this year's edition of the periodical which showcases the actions that took place during the school year 2014-2015.

- To reinforce students' contact with cultural activity of the community.
- To promote young people's lifelong active participation in culture and arts.
- To connect school music education with community music, thus enriching the Music Curriculum and formal music learning.
- To foster a diverse and comprehensive education for future artists, as well as to increase public participation in the arts, through appropriately designed musical experiences that promote musicality and creativity.
- To demystify the notion of "classical orchestra" and "classical musicians", firstly through enhancing active listening skills and secondly, through active participation in diverse musical activities.

- To develop personal, interpersonal communication and collaborative learning skills.
- To develop a positive attitude towards traditional heritage.
- To develop a positive attitude towards music in an intercultural context.
- To adapt to 21st century challenges such as ensuring equal opportunities for all, promoting active citizenship and developing technology skills.
- To enhance innovative entrepreneurship by contributing to the personal and professional development of musicians.



FUTURE GOALS:

- To ensure that all students have equal opportunities to participate in a music educational programme at least once a year.
- To promote further advancement of partnerships between cultural and educational institutions, where all stakeholders will contribute to the content and implementation of the above programmes, as well as sharing costs.
- To improve and disseminate music educational programmes through the use of digital technology, e.g. internet connections, digital recording, etc.

- Continuous improvement of music educational programmes through systematic assessment and feedback.
- Further development of music educational programmes s in the context of the Open School and All-Day School institutions.








The "Music composition annual contest"

The contest was held in December 2014, within the framework of the cooperation between the Ministry of Education and Culture, the non-profit "Photos Photiades" Foundation and the Cyprus Broadcasting Corporation, with the participation of students from all over Cyprus. For the first time this year the contest included Gymnasium as well as Lyceum students.

Three composition contests are included in the "Music composition annual contest":

- The 6th "Marios Tokas" song writing contest, commemorating the Cypriot composer Marios Tokas.
- The 4th "Costas Montis" song writing contest, based on lyrics by the renowned Cypriot poet.
- The 2nd Instrumental composition contest commemorating this year the Cypriot composer Solon Michaelides.

F. Partnerships between the Lefkosia Regional Orchestra, the Pafos Regional Orchestra, public and private secondary education schools, the Pafos Music Lyceum, the Pafos Municipality and other Communities

The establishment of regional orchestras is another innovation of the Ministry of Education and Culture, which has been implemented in secondary education by a decision of the Council of Ministers in November 2003. Music teachers who are specialised in orchestral conducting have been appointed as conductors and the orchestra is open to all students through audition. The aim of such activities is to offer young people the opportunity for enhancing creativity and communication skills, create incentives for qualitative music performance and enhance collaboration with the community in the context of the development of music education. The repertoire varies accordingly, from classical to Cypriot and Greek, as well as students' compositions.

F1. The Lefkosia Regional Orchestra

The Lefkosia Regional orchestra has been active since 2003 and was led in 2014-2015 by Kyriakos Limniotis.


