Primo Search

Primo is a search engine that allows users to search a number of databases at the same time. You can search Primo using the search box underneath the eLibraryUSA logo on our website. You must be logged into your individual account or using a publicly-accessible computer in an Information Resource Center or American Corner to access articles from commercial databases in the search results. You can use the Primo search box to search across InfoUSA, Academic and General OneFile, Project Gutenberg, Hathi Trust, and Public Library of Science.
