

Academic OneFile Provides access to over 42 million journal articles going back to 1980. It focuses on the subjects of physical sciences, technology, medicine, social sciences, the arts, theology, and literature.

BookFlix An interactive literacy resource geared for early readers, reluctant readers and English language learners. The collection consists of 95 fictional video storybooks from Weston Woods with non-fiction ebooks from Scholastic. Interactive reading features include a read-along option, definitions and narrated text, author biographies, web links and resources for educators.

Business Source Premier This is the industry's most used business research database, providing full text for more than 2,300 journals, including full text for more than 1,100 peer-reviewed titles.

Multiple directories can be crosssearched or users can mine individual directories for the particular kinds of data they contain, such as financial information for companies, circulation figures for publications, and much more.

Library, Information Science & Technology Abstracts With Full Text This resource indexes more than 600 journals and other materials that focus on librarianship, online information retrieval, information management and more. The full text of 330 journals is also included.

Literature Resource Center This is a comprehensive database on literary topics, authors, and their works. It includes full-text scholarly articles from more than 360 academic journals and literary magazines, thousands of poems and short stories published in contemporary journals and magazines, book reviews and biographical essays.

LitFinder LitFinder is a repository of full-text literary works, including around 150,000 poems, short stories, plays and speeches.
