### The world's largest twins festival

The world's largest annual meeting of twins takes place in Twinsburg, Ohio. More than 3,000 sets of twins, triplets and quadruplets take part in the event. The meeting offers entertainment, food, a twins' parade, music, talent shows and contests for the "most alike" and "least alike" twin. The organisers describe it as it's a once-in-a lifetime experience to be here.

The festival has its own traditions. An unwritten festival rule, for example, says that identical twins are identically dressed, too. The opening ceremony is also the same every year and immediately after that, there is a parade.

The festival attracts many members of the scientific community because it is a place where they can compare "apples and apples". The twins who take part in the festival can participate in research projects if they want to. Ten teams of researchers study the sets of twins available. Identical twins have 100% matching DNA, offering scientists the opportunity to compare between genetically identical people and try to discover, for example, why one identical twin is happy but the other is not.

At the same time, Pittsburgh's Carlow University is studying how our DNA affects our behaviour online. They are looking into the amount of time each twin spends on social networks or shopping online. They are trying to find out if it is in the twins' nature or if it is the way their parents bring them up. It may be many years before they come up with the answer.
