Attainment Targets: By the end of the lesson students will be able to:

- 1.1. get the gist and spot specific details from a reading text about staycations
- 2.1 compare and contrast different types of holidays
- 2.2 discuss and present their staycation ideas.

Teaching Targets

Viewing and reading:

- 1.1.1 types of holidays / travel and related vocabulary.
- 1.1.2 information from a video clip and a reading text on staycations.
- 1.1.3. skimming and scanning skills.

Speaking

- 2.1.1 oral presentation of staycation route.
- 2.1.2 descriptive adjectives
- 2.1.2. promotional and advertising skills.

PRIOR KNOWLEDGE: descriptive adjectives Vocabulary related to travel / holidays

PROCEDURE:

ACTIVITY 1 – INTRODUCTION

T asks ss to close their eyes and she plays soft background music of ocean waves while describing a holiday scene. Students visualize the scene. Then in pairs students describe the scene they imagined referring to the actual destinations and things they can do there.

Artistic students may draw it. Afterwards they may share the scene with the class or present and describe their drawing.

T tells ss that they will watch a video clip about a different type of holidays to be introduced to the topic of staycations.

T asks ss the following questions and discussion follows.

- 1. What is the video clip about?
- 2. How are these holidays similar/different to the holidays we all know?
- 3. What are the benefits?

Teacher arranges the answers to the above questions in a word cloud on the board. As an extension, additional brainstorming may occur related to the students` own ideas / experiences on staycations.

ACTIVITY 2:

Students open their books on p.70 they are asked to skim the text and in pairs go through ex. 3. They are advised to underline the key words of the statements before they read the text. Students are asked to provide justification for their answers and sometimes paraphrase / find synonyms of certain words in the text.

ACTIVITY 3:

In pairs students read the blog again and go through ex. 4 completing the sentences. Students check with a partner. Teacher elicits answers from the whole class as complete sentences. Answers can be organized on the board and ss copy them so that they have a reference in their notebook.

ACTIVITY 4:

Students are divided into 5 groups and they discuss the questions in ex 1.

Then, students are given a scenario in order to express their ideas.

'You work for the Cyprus Ministry of Tourism and Culture as advertisers. You have been asked to plan a 5 day staycation route to promote the attractions of your town to locals and suggest some related activities'. Each group should plan one of the five days and is given a template with ideas and a picture of the attraction. Each group is given time to prepare and then make a presentation of their staycation day to the locals. Ideas of descriptive adjectives are provided on the template. The teacher is one of their colleagues and acts as the co – ordinator of the presentation.

CLOSURE / QUICK REVIEW.

Based on what they have learnt today, students say words / phrases related to staycations.

FOLLOW UP ACTIVITY/ INDEPENDENT PRACTICE OPPORTUNITIES

Teacher prepares students for a classroom or homework project. They have to present the idea of staycations in any way they wish:

- Diary entry about your last staycation.
- Design a flyer / leaflet for a three day staycation in your own area.
- Powerpoint presentation
- Poster
- Article for a travel magazine on the pros and cons of staycations.
- Project with cutouts pictures etc
- Design a website promoting staycations in your city.
