WALT DISNEY

Walt Disney was one of the most famous people in history. He has touched the lives of millions of children and adults alike. He holds the record for most Academy Awards after winning a total of twenty-six Oscars. He created some of the most famous cartoon characters, movies, and theme parks of the 20th Century.



Disney was born in 1901 in Chicago, USA. At a very young age he developed a great love for drawing. When he was just 10, he discovered the world of theatre and cinema and he fell in love with their magic. He even became the cartoonist for his high school newspaper.

After school, Disney decided to move to Hollywood and set up the Disney Brothers Studio with his brother Roy. There, he created a character based on a pet mouse he once had. He gave the mouse his own voice. Disney's wife Lillian, named this mouse "Mickey". Mickey Mouse starred in Disney's first sound film "Steamboat Willie". By

1930, Mickey Mouse was the world's most popular cartoon character and starred in many animated films. Mickey's success brought more animated films and more famous characters created by Disney such as Donald Duck, Goofy and Pluto.

Inspired by a small playground he built for his two daughters in his back garden, Disney went on to create Disneyland theme park and has managed to create a worldwide name connected to entertainment. He died in 1966.

The term **graffiti** comes from the Greek word "grafein" which means "to write". People started drawing and painting on walls thousands of years ago. Prehistoric people painted on the walls of caves, and those paintings are now important works of art. Graffiti first appeared in ancient Rome and Egypt.

Today, people draw on walls. However, this is not always considered art; it is called graffiti. Graffiti art takes a lot of forms: it can be something small and personal, like the initials of the artist, or something much larger, like a mural. Most graffiti

artists call themselves "writers" and they sign with spray paint or a marker. This signature is known as a "tag". Groups of writers who are friends are called "crews," and new "writers" are named "toys".

Banksy is the name of a British artist who uses it to sign his work. His art appears on walls in streets all over the world for everyone to see. Through his graffiti, he expresses his feelings and sends messages about everyday life to the rest of the world.
